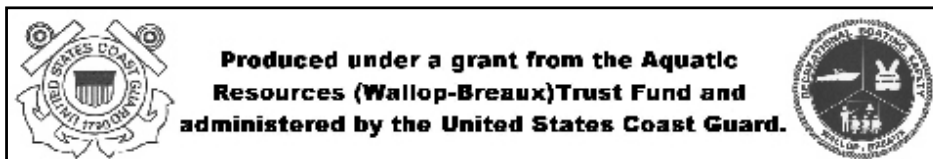


# PHOTO SEARCH

We will pay for pictures of

in Life Jackets

- ◆ **Photos will be purchased for up to \$100.**
- ◆ **No limit on number of submissions.**
- ◆ **No entry fees.**

The BoatU.S. Foundation is building a photo file of hunters, anglers, and general boaters wearing life jackets on boats. Photos will be purchased on a first-come, first-serve basis until monies are depleted. Entries will not be accepted after June 1, 2005.



# Submission Guidelines

Sportsmen and boaters must be wearing life jackets appropriate to their sport and their body size, and the jacket must be worn correctly. Photos of unsafe boating behavior will not be purchased. For background information on safe behaviors, visit <http://www.boatus.com/foundation/sportsman>.

Color action photos are preferred. High resolution (300+ dpi) .jpg or .tif photos can be submitted via disk, or hard copy photos larger than 4 X 6 " will be accepted.

Photos will be selected based on the effectiveness of the image. Payment level is dependent on quality of image and appropriateness of subject matter. Maximum payment per photo is \$100.

All purchased photos will be given unlimited use by the U.S. Coast Guard and the BoatU.S. Foundation who will use or distribute photos to promote boating safety. The photographer will retain rights to the photos and may resell or use the photos.

The photographer is responsible for obtaining model release forms if necessary. By accepting payment for photos, the photographer is assuming all responsibility for securing necessary release forms and permissions.

Submit as many photos as you like. Submissions will only be returned if accompanied by a SASE with adequate postage.

Photos will be purchased on a first-come, first-serve basis until monies are depleted. Entries will not be accepted after June 1, 2005.
